(Juniperus scopulorum 'Medora')

Medora Juniper is an upright, narrow variety of Rocky Mountain Juniper originally grown in North Dakota. It is extremely cold hardy and will tolerate cold, dry winds of the Plains. It tolerates a wide variety of soils, but does best in well drained locations and will not tolerate standing water. It is tolerant of moderate shade, so it is versatile in the landscape setting. Its shape requires very little maintenance to stay tightly



columnar. It is a male cultivar, so does not produce seed. The silvery, blue-green foliage is a nice contrast in a formal arrangement. It can be used as a specimen plant, or planted in groups as a hedge or windscreen.
