Shangri-La Ginkgo

(Ginkgo biloba 'Shangri-La')

Mature Height: 40'-50'

Mature Spread: 30'-40'

Growth Rate: Slow

Fall Color: Yellow

Shangri-La is a male, seedless variety of this ancient Japanese deciduous conifer tree. It is quite slow-growing, but easy to cultivate and maintain in the landscape. The leaves are a soft-green and fan shaped, making this tree unique and very ornamental. Ginkgos will tolerate most soil conditions and even saline areas. It has been used in landscapes for thousands of years, so has



proved itself as both a shade, and an ornamental tree. The fall color is a brilliant yellow, that starts rather early in the season.
