Canada Red Cherry is a popular ornamental tree due to its red leaves all summer and the fragrant, white blooms in the spring. The leaves of this tree emerge green in the spring with the blooms and develop the characteristic maroon-red color as they mature into the summer. Its native range is nearly the entire United States. It tolerates

a wide variety of soils and growing conditions. It has been shown to tolerate temperatures well below freezing. The Canada Red Cherry is a popular street tree in Anchorage, Alaska! It makes a beautiful specimen tree or hedgerow. The tiny, red cherries are edible and are a favorite of wildlife.
