(Celtis occidentalis)

Mature Height: 40'-45'

Mature Spread: 30'-35'

Growth Rate: Mod-Fast

Fall color: Yellow

Hackberry is a hardy tree that is native to the Midwest. It does best in well-drained soils, but will do well in a wide variety of conditions. It tolerates urban conditions well, and its smaller size makes it an excellent city tree. One of its most distinguishing characteristics is the warty protrusions on the bark. It produces tiny, purple fruits that are sought after by many animals for food. Hackberry is becoming increasingly popular as the trend toward native trees continues. Its adaptability makes it a great choice for many applications.
