(Quercus rubra)

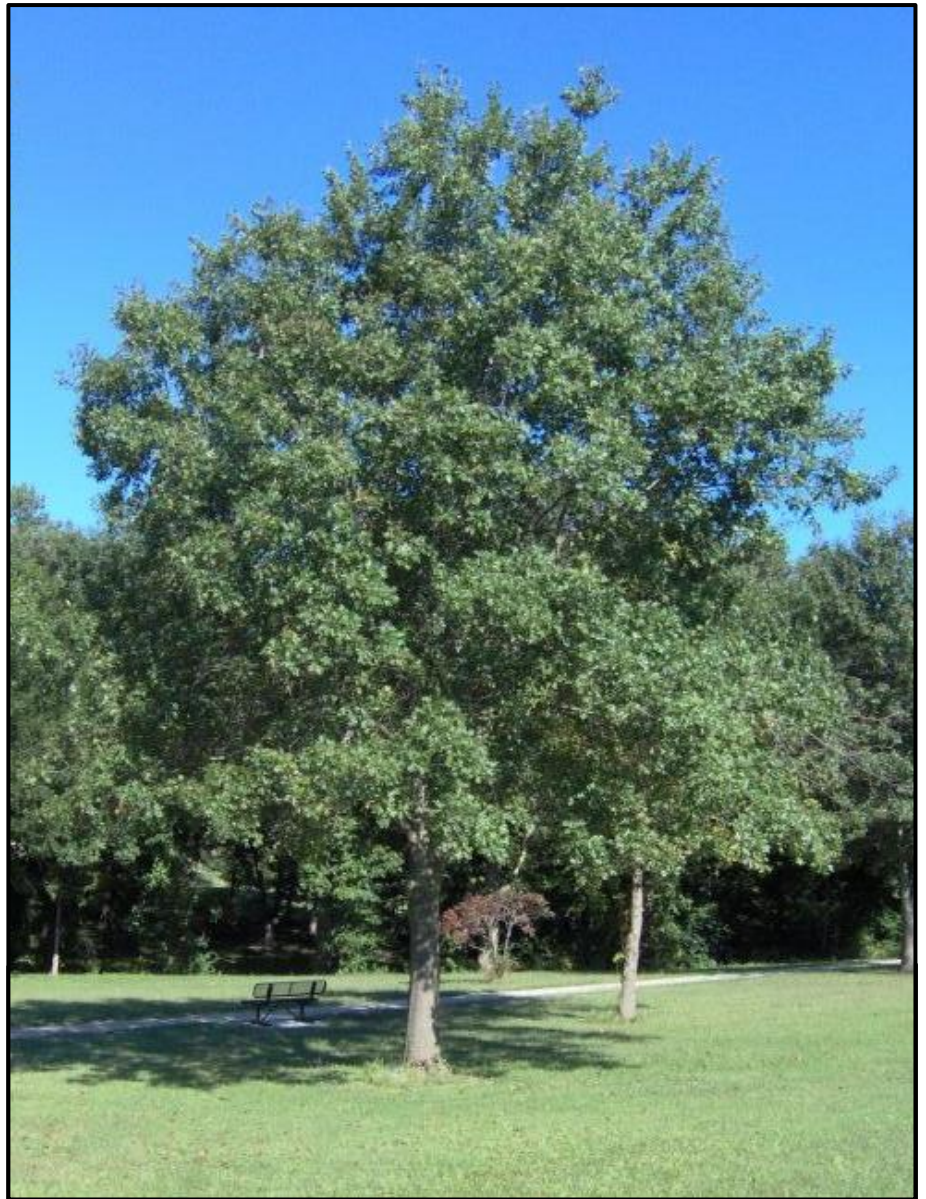
Mature Height: 45'-55'

Fall color: Red

Northern Red Oak is a faster-growing variety that becomes a large, attractive shade tree. The foliage is bright green in the summer and becomes a vibrant red in the fall. It is a hardy, native tree that does well in a variety of conditions. It tolerates urban conditions better than the majority of oaks. It is an attractive tree



that provides medium-sized acorns that are valuable food for wildlife. Although it is fast growing, it is also long lived and specimens well over 300 years old have been documented. The red color of the leaves develops late into the fall and it can continue to provide color to the landscape for months.
